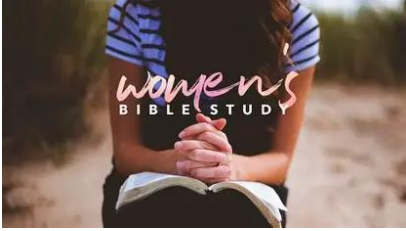

Cross of Christ Council Meeting Minutes April 14, 2026

Meeting was called to order by Anthony Nemcek and the mission statement was read.

The meeting agenda was approved with amendments, and the March meeting minutes were approved as written.

Unfinished Business

* **Pastor's Report**-Pastor provided a written report in his absence. The report was a summary of activities Pastor has been involved in, including the new bible study at Tinta Wita and working with the Worship and Music Committee to narrow the scope of the A/V improvement project. Upcoming events include Confirmation Sunday on May 10 and the kickoff of the Service and Witness Committee's Vision and Vitality task force. Pastor also mentioned a potential for some upcoming PTO needs.

***Accessibility Task Force** - No updates at this time. This agenda item has been added as a placeholder. Activities will begin following the Dahlen Hall exterior project.

***Dahlen Hall Exterior** – The task force will be reviewing all the bids that have been received and will bring a recommendation to Council at its May meeting with a congregational vote on the project by the end of May. A fundraising plan will be created following a positive vote by the congregation.

New Business

Committee Reports

*Finance – Council reviewed a rough report, but final reports will be forthcoming as Clergy Financial Resources works through some additional clarification. Tithely will be set up this month, and by the end of May any congregants currently using Simply Giving to give electronically will have to transition to the new system. The church secretary will offer assistance to anyone needing help. Council approved a one-time \$250 compensation to Deanna Gehloff for the additional hours spent getting the church's bookkeeping and payroll moved over to CFR.

*Property Management – Council discussed investigating options to provide better lighting in the steps from the Narthex to the basement. A lithium-powered motion light may be a good option. Darwin Fox will get bids for crack sealing and seal coating the driveway and parking lot. Crack sealing is crucial, seal coating should also be done to ensure the longevity of the asphalt.

*Worship & Music – The committee reviewed bids for A/V installation. Considering moving to a hymn of the month format.

*Learning & Youth – Confirmation Sunday will be May 10th. The banquet for confirmands and their families will be on May 3rd from 3-6. May 3 is the last day of Sunday School.

*Service & Witness – The committee is kicking off its Vision and Vitality task force and is looking for volunteers. The goal is to establish 1-2 ministry priorities for the congregation to pursue beginning in 2027.

*Missions – Granola bars are being collected in the narthex.

*Stewardship – No updates at this meeting.

*Personnel – No updates this meeting.

A motion was made and seconded to adjourn the meeting. - Motion Passed.
